Re: Notice of Intent under Nassau County/JEA Water and Wastewater Interlocal Agreement dated December 17, 2001 (the "Agreement").

Dear Mike:

Thank you for taking time to meet with us on August 8. As discussed, the purpose of that meeting was to confirm that you were aware of publication of JEA ITN 127-19, a public solicitation inviting "proposals that are aligned with JEA's goals of maximizing customer, community, environmental, and financial value over the long term." As all are aware, such proposals may contemplate JEA's consideration of a sale or lease of certain JEA water and wastewater facilities in Nassau County. This letter serves as formal written Notice of Intent from JEA to the County under Section 5.1 of the Agreement, and confirms, as discussed at the outset of the meeting, that the County does not intend to participate in JEA ITN 127-19.

Please provide a written response (if required under your bylaws or local rules, a board resolution) either, (a) exercising the County's right of first refusal under Section 5.2 of the Agreement or (b) waiving and rejecting such right and discharging JEA of further obligations under Section 5.2 of the Agreement. Failure by the County to respond within ninety (90) days of this letter shall be deemed a waiver of the County's rights under Section 5.2 of the Agreement.
