In an associated document signed by Wannemacher, he agreed to waive any and benefits, including the obligation of JEA to execute a three-mc-+-

ion and transition agreement, and any payments owed by JEA un the Employee Protection and Retention Program Agreement adopted by JEA's board in July and later rescinded.

Wannemacher also agreed to appear voluntarily for up to seven hours of questioning under oath by city attorneys and investigators regarding his period of employment with JEA.






